Our classic Cabernet Sauvignon is medium-bodied and complex yet clearly approachable and will keep you warm on a "three dog night". Flavors of spicy cherry, hints of herbs, cassis, currant and vanilla make for an extremely drinkable wine.

Cabernets in this style complement most beef and pork dishes as well as pasta and bean recipes. Poultry in a sauce with fresh herbs and medium flavored cheeses are also great treats.
