Twist off the cap and all you're left with is a bright shiny collar and just a great whine!

Head Breeder Notes

Still “top dog” as far as whites go, this Chardonnay has wonderful aromas of citrus and fresh cut green apples. Its crisp, mineral style is delightfully refreshing with flavors of pineapple and mountain-ripe apples. The finish is crisp and clean balanced nicely by mild acidity.

Chow Hound Choices

Chicken is a favorite, but it also pairs nicely with spring greens lightly tossed with your favorite dressing. Other main dish choices are grilled pork chops or chicken.
