And talk about convenience. Storing wine bottles in the fridge is no longer a hassle. No leaking when you lay them down and if you're all thumbs, or paws, with a corkscrew, you're in luck. Twist off the cap and all you're left with is a bright shiny collar and just a great whine!

Head Breeder Notes

A bit wild, a bit fun, and truly lovable — describes this “mutt” to a T. It's a delightful blend with intoxicating aromas of citrus and pear with a hint of honeysuckle. The flavors are reminiscent of pineapple and lychee fruit with just a touch of oak and sweetness to nicely balance the acidity. Its refreshing style makes it a “must have” for all occasions.

Chow Hound Choices

Not too dry...not too sweet this white truly goes with almost anything. On the lighter side, salads or fruit plates are the ticket. But if you're having dinner, try it with grilled Chicken, Chinese take-out or any kind of fish or shrimp.
